ENSURING EQUAL VOTING ACCESS



In the 2023 State Election, MILAD took an important step to support individuals with disabilities (OKU) by providing transportation facilities, enabling them to participate in the democratic process. We believe that OKU individuals, like any other citizen, have the inherent right to choose their preferred governing party.

However, challenges persist at polling stations. Despite having a dedicated lane for OKU and senior citizens (Saluran 1), a 5-inch curb at the entrance creates significant accessibility obstacles for wheelchair users.

Moreover, the assistance provided by attendants unfamiliar with aiding wheelchair users has compromised the safety of OKU individuals. These issues limit accessibility and undermine OKU citizens' autonomy and dignity.

We urge the government to promptly address these concerns. Installing removable ramps at polling stations is a practical solution to alleviate these accessibility challenges and ensure OKU individuals can fully participate in the democratic process.

Access to voting is a fundamental right, and MILAD's advocacy in the 2023 State Election underscores our commitment to inclusivity and equality for OKU citizens. It's a call for action and a reminder that democracy must be accessible to all.

We stand firm in our dedication to advocate for the rights and wellbeing of individuals with disabilities. Together, let's champion accessible voting and work towards a future where inclusivity is a reality for everyone.
